
Evolving Compassion in End of Life Care -2-

- The numbers in the lower left reference page numbers in Urgent Whispers: Care of the Dying -

Each phrase above represents a concept in the end of life caregiving process. As worded, it may not be clear to you. But without trying to think too hard about it, make a decision as to what each means *to you* in terms of end of life care. Then, you have a total of **20 points** to distribute between these **12** boxes. Each box can have as few as **0** points or as many as **5**. The total should add up to **20**. No fractions.

Which seem more important to you? Less important? What *feels* right? How will you decide? Allocate your 20 points according to your arrangement of each phrase's priority.

There are no "wrong" or "right" answers. Because 12 does not divide evenly into 20, you will have to make some choices for prioritizing. What will be your basis for those decisions?
